## 124,638

Congratulations to everyone who contributed to a total Red Barrel collection of 124,638 food items in 2011! The total is an increase of 6,836 food items over 2010. This number also includes the sale of 9,177 Hunger Sacks. Store Directors, store employees, volunteers who collect food from the barrels and Sack Saturday volunteers all take credit for enabling this accomplishment. Needless to say, the generous customers who contribute food to the barrels and regularly buy hunger sacks are the ones who make this all happen. Applause to all!

### Red Barrel Events

**Des Moines Winter Games Polar Plunge** – Friday, February 3rd<sup>h</sup> at 6:00 p.m. at Sleepy Hollow Sports Park. Although the barrel will not be plunging, it will be collecting canned items of food that are the entrance fee for this event.

**Des Moines Winter Games Children's Events** – Saturday, February 4, 9:00 a.m. to noon at Brenton Skating Plaza. The barrel will again be collecting food items as an entrance fee to this event.

**"Super Bowl Sack Saturdays"** will be held at various stores in the Metro on February 4<sup>th</sup>. Shoppers will be encouraged to build their own sacks from the list of most needed items, with a special emphasis on soup to celebrate the Super Bowl on February 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Boy Scout Troop #46** from Windsor Heights United Methodist Church will hold their annual Sack Saturday event on March 10<sup>th</sup> at the Hy-Vee in Windsor Heights. In 2011, this event sold 192 sacks.

### Kiwanis One Day

Each year Kiwanis Clubs around the world join in a day of service called Kiwanis One Day. This year Kiwanis One Day is Saturday, April 21<sup>st</sup>. The Red Barrel Program and Sack Saturdays have been selected by Kiwanis Clubs in our area to be the beneficiary of Kiwanis One Day activities. Plans are underway in the Des Moines Metro and surrounding communities for multiple Sack Saturdays taking place throughout the day in recognition of this event.

Kiwanis Clubs and their members play an important roll in the life of the Red Barrel Program. This will be particularly true on the 21<sup>st</sup> of April as they collect food and cash donations to support the Food Pantry Network.
