RED BARREL SEEKING TO REBRAND; EXPAND

Des Moines, Iowa—With the beginning of Fiscal Year 2017-18 comes exciting new changes for the Red Barrel. As DMARC as an organization has begun setting new goals for the new fiscal year, so too has the Development department and with it, the Red Barrel program. As we strive towards increasing donations and funding across the board, we've begun developing an actionable plan to help meet our new goals. Included in that plan is a rebranding and relaunching of the Red Barrel by its anniversary date in April of 2018. Also included in the plan are a new design and new materials to be used in the construction of the barrels, an "adopt-a-barrel" program to help expand its reach into schools and businesses, and a mascot to help promote the barrel in parades and public appearances. Currently, the search is on for key stakeholders and other parties interested in participating and serving on a Red Barrel committee to help oversee the development of the new program. Along with changes to the Red Barrel program will come a change to this publication, the Red Barrel News. As of this edition, the monthly hard-copy version will no longer be available. A quarterly Red Barrel report in hard copy form will be also available as a new, added section of DMARC's quarterly publication, The Voice. Subscribers to Red Barrel News who are not already subscribed to The Voice should do so in order to continue to receive hard-copy updates. The first quarterly Red Barrel report will appear in the winter edition of The Voice which is due out at the beginning of November.
